

Terms and conditions of sale 2024-04

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General

- These terms and conditions of sale are valid from 1st October 2024 until further notice or until 31st December 2024 at the latest
- All services are based on the currently valid version of the general terms and conditions of TFG.
- Any other services used by the customer or any additional costs incurred by the customer will be charged according to outlay.
- Disclaimer: Detention, demurrage, storage and other shipping charges shall not be refunded by TFG
- All terms and conditions quoted apply to the transport of ISO-standard containers.
- These terms and conditions of sale are available in German and English. In case of doubt the German version shall prevail.
- Working days within the meaning of these terms and conditions of sale are Monday to Friday.
- Rates for transports from/to Italy on request.

Transport service

All transport products as offered by TFG are subject to the valid timetable at www.transfracht.com. The TFG transport service includes the following rail transport modes:

- combined transport (CT)
- combined transport / self-pick-up /self-delivery (C/S)
- rail siding traffic (RST)
- inland terminal to terminal (HTT)

as well as

- road transport of various kinds (transfer services at the seaport, empty container positioning, etc.)
- terminal services

furthermore:

- Containers must not exceed the loading gauge and must be delivered in-gauge.
- TFG reserves the right to select the routing or mode of transport.

Prices

- The currently applicable prices are published in the price centre at www.transfracht.com. Prices are subject to operating feasibility and apply only as long as the current production concepts are maintained.
- All prices listed below are in euros (EUR).
- 30' containers are priced as for 40' containers. A surcharge applies to 45' containers.
- At seaports, for the loading points with a TFG rail link, pick-up/drop-off shall be "to wagon", otherwise "to chassis". For transports from and to Bremen Roland Ubf, handover or takeover is deemed to occur at the start of crane handling.
- Unless otherwise stated, all prices for road deliveries quoted in these terms and conditions of sale include any road tolls payable in the countries served, and in Switzerland prices include the performance-related heavy vehicle charge (LSVA) and a diesel surcharge, including CO₂ Tax.
- Uncleaned (tank) containers with a gross weight (including tare) of ≥ 5 tonnes will be treated as full containers and priced accordingly.

Trucking services

Road delivery of heavy containers

The container gross weight allowed on the road is generally limited to a maximum of 28 tonnes. Deliveries are possible only by prior arrangement with the relevant customer service office or TFG agency, with times of delivery / acceptance agreed.

The maximum container gross weight for cross-border traffic is 25 tonnes. The relevant road traffic regulations in the countries concerned apply.

Free waiting time in road transport

Prices for combined transport include a free waiting time of two hours at the loading point(s), including customs clearance and weighing points. For pre-carriage and pick-up of containers from depots, no truck waiting time is recorded. Different regulation for side loaders, see page 9 Special equipment.

- Surcharge for each additional half hour: 60.00

If delivery of the container by TFG is later than stipulated, the waiting time shall be calculated from the beginning of loading. Events that are not caused by TFG are excluded (for example, possible delays at non-TFG depots and customs / weighing points). If delivery of the container by TFG is earlier than stipulated, the waiting time shall be calculated from the stipulated time or from the beginning of loading by the customer. If the customer begins loading before the stipulated time, the waiting time shall be calculated from the beginning of loading. If delivery of the container by TFG is at the stipulated time, the free waiting time shall be calculated from that time, regardless of when the customer begins loading.

TFG reserves the right to wait at the depot for a maximum of one hour due to reasons for which the customer is responsible (no notification of container's entry to the depot, no release and / or suitable container available for pick-up at the depot). Any extra costs incurred will be charged to the customer.

Self-delivery/-pick up in the westports

TFG Transfracht offers the possibility of self-delivery/-pick up by customers at selected terminals in Rotterdam and Antwerp. For self-deliveries, the customer is charged a full cycle handling in each case.

- The above prices do not apply to cross-border traffic.
- Several loading points within a company's premises will be counted as one stop.
- This provision applies to a maximum of three loading points.
- Prices for more than three loading points or distances of more than 200 km can be provided on request.

Weighing services (SOLAS)

TFG Transfracht offers weighing services for combined transport, in compliance with SOLAS regulations. The customer using the weighing service has sole responsibility for fulfilling the obligations arising from the SOLAS guidelines.

TFG's SOLAS-compliant weighing services are subject to additional charges:

The above prices include the approach to the weighing station, the execution of the weighing process, the preparation of the weighing notes with the gross weight of the container, and the transmission of the weighing notes to the customer.

The provision for the free waiting time for trucks shall remain unchanged, regardless of whether SOLAS weighing services are used or not.

TFG Transfracht shall not be liable for any costs or delays incurred during the course of the weighing process (e.g. increased waiting times, new arrivals) or for any further costs that may result (e.g. due to delayed shipments to shipowners or storage/non-loading charges in seaport).

Weighing by a third party (customer arranges for the weighing procedure to be taken over by a third party)

If the weighing facility is located within a 10-kilometre radius (one way) of the relevant TFG terminal

Road deliveries without rail; hitching and unhitching

A surcharge shall apply for road deliveries without a link to rail transport and for cases in which, according to the customer’s requirements, the container remains on the chassis with the tractor removed at the loading point or the vehicle with the container on is moved.

Prices apply per container and delivery plus any national road tolls and diesel.

The starting point in the calculation of these prices is the respective terminal. The prices for pick-up/drop-off at a non-TFG depot are calculated based on the distance to the TFG terminal. Cross-border road transport is available on request.

Chassis rent

The first 24 hours of chassis rent are included in the surcharge. Saturdays, Sundays and Germany-wide public holidays are free of charge. Chassis rent per additional 24-hour period:

Truck shuttle

Start of shuttle: Positioning of first container with unhitching at the loading point.
 Ongoing shuttle: A container is positioned and exchanged with the container already there.
 Completion of shuttle: When it is no longer possible or necessary to exchange containers, the last container is picked up. This completes the shuttle. Only one hitching/unhitching surcharge will be applicable for the entire positioning operation. If any individual containers remain at the loading point for more than 24 hours before being picked up, chassis rent will be charged.

Transport of empty containers

A surcharge is levied for the commissioning of an empty container transport in the inland between terminal and depot (both ways) with corresponding empty transport by rail. For all terminal-depot combinations not mentioned, price on request.

Pick-up and drop-off of empty containers

A surcharge is payable for the pick-up or drop-off of an empty container in combination with a full container transport. The pick-up or drop-off can be conducted at the transshipment terminal for the related depot for the same surcharge. Empty containers can be picked up or dropped off in combination with a full container transport at other depots than those listed in the table. Prices are calculated as multi-stop services.

Special equipment

TFG can provide special equipment for transfers at seaports at certain terminals subject to an extra charge. Depending on the technical and organisational situation, the availability of the necessary equipment cannot always be guaranteed. Due to limited availability, special equipment can be provided only upon due notification and confirmed time of use at least four business days in advance and upon confirmation of the responsible TFG agency. For tipper chassis, the waiting time regulation stated under Truck - Waiting time for road delivery applies. (Page 3) A free waiting time of 30 minutes applies to the use of side loaders. After that we charge EUR 70 per half hour or part thereof. The maximum gross weight including container tare applies.

- Note regarding Austrian terminals: If containers are not delivered to the terminal on the day the train departs or not picked up on the day the train arrives, a handling surcharge will be charged in accordance with the applicable terms and conditions of the terminal. If additional handling is required (e.g. customs inspection), a surcharge will be levied. The handling operation is invoiced separately, a handling surcharge will be charged in accordance with the applicable terms and conditions of the terminal.

Container storage

Temporary storage is available at inland terminals served by TFG for containers in CT and C/S transport. If the storage space is full, the customer is required to stop further containers from arriving at TFG’s request.

- Load units that enter a terminal on a nationwide public holiday will be invoiced as incoming load units on the next business day.
- Loaded containers that arrive by rail on a Friday later than 3 pm or on a Saturday or Sunday will be invoiced as if they had arrived on the following Monday. (For the Basel terminals, loaded containers that arrive by rail on Fridays/Saturdays/Sundays will be invoiced as if they had arrived on the following Monday.)
- In the case of empty containers, TFG must be informed when the order is placed whether the containers are depot or positioning containers. If no instructions are provided, incoming containers will automatically be stored at the depot. Short-notice access to unannounced positioning containers or numerical access will not be possible in the depot area.
- If a transport-related storage at the hinterland terminal is subject to charges, additional handling charges will be incurred.
- The charge for storage until onward carriage is incurred on an ongoing basis and results from the storage surcharges plus additional surcharges for mid-term storage and long-term storage.

Reefer containers

TFG offers transport of reefer containers, yet explicitly does not assume any liability for damage resulting from unavailable cooling or heating systems. No cooling or heating system is available during transport. Furthermore, not all terminals can provide hook-ups to cooling systems. Reefer connections at terminals, if available, can be provided on request and for a surcharge. If additional handling is required, TFG reserves the right to pass on any costs incurred to the customer.

Transfers at hinterland terminals

Munich

As a result of limited storage capacity in the DUSS terminals mentioned, space is reserved for removal. Containers with an increased storage period are charged a fee for the provision of extended storage space after a certain period of time.

Customs services

Presentation of goods to customs and customs inspection

A surcharge (per journey) is levied for delivery of goods to the loading point's local customs office:

Presentation of goods to other customs offices will be charged as multi-stop (p.5). We keep the right to charge for any parking fees incurred.

In the case of cross-border deliveries, the rates stated in our price lists are always calculated via the nearest border customs office in terms of traffic geographical location. In the case of order specifications that deviate from this, we will pass on any additional costs incurred due to additional kilometers.

Needed information and deadlines to create NCTS-T1

The following deadlines apply for the transmission of customs data:

- NCTS-T1 from German seaport
 - 2 working days (12 pm) before the date of dispatch
- NCTS-T1 from German hinterland
 - 5h before cut-off time according to the valid timetable

For the creation of a NCTS-T1 additional data is required:

German description of goods in accordance with leaflet on customs declarations / ATB-No., if necessary, splitting / value of goods + currency per goods position / customs office of destination / T1 consignee / weight per commodity item / 6-digit customs tariff number per item of goods / GGED Yes / No.

If the required customs data are not available to the TFG by the specified deadline or if changes are made after the deadline, there is no entitlement to rail transport on the booked date of dispatch.

If the data transfer is not carried out via our E-Services or Interface, see section administration surcharge (p.12). NCTS-T1 shall be terminated by the customer no later than the specified day of presenting the goods again to customs.

Customs presentation (T1-NCTS)

If a consignee is not an Authorized Consignee (AC) in the T1-NCTS customs procedure, the journey to the customs office (customs presentation) must be booked by the client with the complete address as a separate delivery address.

If such a journey is not booked, TFG automatically assumes that the consignee has AC status and hands over the T1-NCTS transit accompanying document to the consignee against receipt. The consignee then has the obligation to terminate the T1-NCTS in due time at the customs office of destination.

Container high security seals

A surcharge will be levied for the attachment of container seals at inland terminals:

- per container seal (terminals) 35.00
- per container seal (seaports) acc. expense

Services relating to dangerous goods and waste

General information on dangerous goods and waste

- TFG transports dangerous goods of all classes and waste (not via Bamberg Hafen Ubf and Passau Hafen). This excludes animal by-products in accordance with the Animal By-Products Disposal Act (TierNebG) of categories 1 and 2. Animal by-products of category 3 can be transported in compliance with Regulation (EC) No. 1069/2009 and Regulation (EU) No. 142/2011. Chilled or frozen animal by-products of category 3 are excluded.
- The transport of Class 1 dangerous goods containers (except Class 1.4 S) and explosive substances (S.16) is only possible in Combined Transport on request.
- Non-hazardous waste (green list) is transported in CT. In the case of hazardous waste / waste subject to notification, a site-specific feasibility check must be carried out and is then only possible with a special offer.
- The corresponding number from the Waste Catalogue Ordinance (AVV) must be specified in the order data for all waste transports.

TFG does not transport dangerous goods in the following classes:

- When dangerous goods are transported, the customer must provide all necessary information in writing and to observe all national and international regulations.
- Where use is made of exceptions or special approval, all deviations from the applicable legislation must be stated and a copy of the relevant document attached to the transport. All waste shipments must be accompanied by the full approval. Confirmation of acceptance of the waste by the final recipient must also be submitted.
- For transport by sea, a container packing certificate under section 5.4.2 IMDG Code shall accompany the rail and road transport document. This applies only to ISO containers, not to tank containers.
- The container must be labelled for transport by sea (IMDG) at the beginning of transport. Any load unit labelling that is incomplete will be completed by TFG in consultation with and on behalf of the customer.
- Extra costs can arise in the transport of any dangerous goods and waste due to the need for special equipment and/or special regulations (e.g., co-driver, equipment, routing, special approval).
- It is imperative that the TFG Dangerous Goods Officer be notified via our customer service in the event of any accidents
- TFG’s dangerous goods safety advisor must be informed of emergencies or accidents (E-Mail: Gefahrgutbeauftragter-TFG@transfracht.com)

Safety surcharge (hazardous goods surcharge and waste surcharge)

A surcharge is levied for the transport of dangerous goods and waste. (No safety surcharge is charged for combined transport for self-collectors and/or self-deliverers and siding traffic).

Temporary storage

Import

Dangerous goods containers must be collected on the day of arrival at the terminal, but at the latest within the opening hours of the working day (of the terminal) following the day of arrival. If this deadline is exceeded, a late fee will be charged for each commenced calendar day, including the day of collection.

Export

Dangerous goods containers must be delivered to the terminal on the day of departure. Delivery on the previous day up to 24 hours before departure at the earliest requires the consent of the terminal operator.

Surcharge

At terminals not listed above, containers must be picked up from the terminal within 24 hours. Any delay charges incurred for containers not picked up within this period shall be passed on to the customer.

The surcharge will be charged in addition to the terminal conditions for interim storage.

Additional services and surcharges

Cancellation and rebooking surcharge

Changes to the dispatch day and cancellations are exempt from charges up to the TFG booking deadline. After this time, any changes to the dispatch day or cancellations are no longer free of charge but shall be subject to a cancellation surcharge. This surcharge will also be charged if containers are not delivered to the terminal before closing time for acceptance (www.transfracht.com) on the booked dispatch day, if shipment is not possible due to incorrect/missing shipment data (e.g. missing or incorrect customs number / container release / commitment note / password / PIN missing/wrong), or if defects in the load units lead to non-shipment.

If a container that was already scheduled for truck delivery is cancelled or its handling cannot be executed due to reasons for which the customer was responsible after booking was completed, a loss of freight charge will be invoiced. If a container has already been loaded for truck delivery, you will be charged according to Surcharge "Road deliveries without rail; hitching and unhitching" for the complete transport. If no physical journey has taken place, no toll, truck capacity and diesel surcharges will be charged.

The full price will be charged for failed transports in the case of port transfers. In the case of cancellations of transports with return to the point of departure, we charge according to the actual costs incurred.

Cargo Opening Surcharge

- Cargo Opening Surcharge - per Container 150.00

Up to 24 hours before the booking deadline, changes to the cargo opening times can be made at no additional cost. After this time, changes and corresponding necessary rebookings are subject to charges. This results from the given delivery times of the terminals in Rotterdam and Antwerp. For Rotterdam a delivery at the earliest 48h is valid; for Antwerp a delivery at the earliest 7 days before Cargo Opening (subject to change), which must be strictly adhered to.

Order modification surcharge

When a customer makes modifications to an order (dispatch date, destination station or train) the DUSS terminal operator calculates a flat surcharge following the delivery of containers to its inland terminals. This surcharge is passed on to the customer.

For the terminal Munich:

- per container 31.00

In case an additional transfer of the container within the terminal will be necessary, the costs will increase by a flat-rate transport fee of

- per container 50.00

Administration surcharge

TFG charges a flat administration surcharge for all orders that are not placed via the Infokette interface or via www.transfracht.com. Furthermore, we reserve the right to charge the organisation fee if additional work is required due to missing / incorrect order data.

- per container 30.00

Mandatory information

To ensure that transportation runs efficiently, the following information must be provided to TFG Transfracht in advance of an import shipment: Confirmed ship arrival, container number, exemption reference, customs documents, hinterland destination terminal, goods description.

Energy surcharge rail

Infrastructure surcharge

Due to the reduction in track access charge support (TraFöG), the additional costs must be passed on to freight costs through an infrastructure surcharge.

Congestion Surcharge

Due to the current high utilisation of the port terminals, the congestion of the inland terminals and the associated irregularities in rail handling, a congestion surcharge has been introduced for transports from / to Hamburg, Wilhelmshaven and Bremerhaven until further notice. The surcharge also applies to our Austrian inland terminals in Salzburg, Enns Graz and Vienna, and to the northern ports: Hamburg, Bremerhaven, Wilhelmshaven, Rotterdam and Antwerpen. The situation is constantly being reassessed and information will be provided on further developments. You can find current information at www.transfracht.com.

Additional ancillary charges

TFG reserves the right to calculate supplements and/or additional ancillary charges to compensate for increases in diesel price including CO₂ Tax and energy price and for the costs of congestion at seaport and inland terminals. Any such supplements or additional ancillary charges shall be listed separately on invoices. Prices quoted by TFG do not take into account the possible introduction of additional costs due to regulations and measures being imposed by local or national authorities. Should any such new costs be introduced, TFG reserves the right to levy the corresponding ancillary charges without delay.

Booking system and requirements

Information required

Bookings must be made via EDI or on www.transfracht.com. For bookings to be correctly accepted and executed, the following minimum details are required:

Freight payer, route, pick-up / drop-off depot for empty containers, loading/unloading point(s), net load weight, container length, height and type, shipping line, vessel, overseas port, dangerous goods or waste: full details, details of out-of-gauge cargo if applicable, preferred day of dispatch

Adjustments Cargo Opening Times:

To ensure smooth loading, it is mandatory to submit the following information incl. subsequently received changes at least 24 hours prior to booked train departure:

Cargo Opening time (posted time on the part of the shipping company), changes to cargo opening time or ship arrivals incl. shipping company booking number, exemption references and/or container/seal numbers incl. customs information.

Additional data for import bookings only:

Container number for loaded containers, customs clearance data

If a customs inspection (document or scan inspection) already exists for a container, this must be notified to TFG in advance during booking. In this case, customs handling / transport execution on the part of TFG is not possible. After successful inspection and release by customs, a corresponding transport can be carried out by TFG.

Orders for loading empty containers from non-TFG depots must also be sent to the depot, which is responsible for checking the loading capacity.
